**Chemical Warheads Response:**

**Request** – A copy of all reports related to the discovery of chemical warheads in Iraq.

~~(S//REL TO USA, ACGU)~~ MNC-I CBRN keeps a running total of all CBRN warheads found in Iraq since 2003. To date MNC-I CBRN is tracking 4251 various types of CBRN munitions discovered in Iraq (See attached CBRN munitions tracker). This count includes munitions that contained a fill, as well as empty CBRN munitions. MNC-I CBRN has shipped two (2) munitions back to Edgewood, Maryland for further analysis. Both munitions sent back were 122mm rocket canisters. The purity of agent is determined by laboratories in the U.S. and not by MNC-I CBRN. For official results of purity tests on munitions found in Iraq, recommend the requestor contact the National Ground Intelligence Center (NGIC). Their website is:

**(U)** This is not the official count, as MNC-I CBRN does not receive information or reports from other government agencies (OGAs) regarding their discovery or operations relating to chemical warheads. For the official reports and numbers, it is recommended the requestor contact the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA) as they have the responsibility of reporting (under conditions of the Chemical Warfare Convention) all munitions that have been discovered, destroyed and/or moved out of Iraq.
